

## The Jackman Training Awards

The Canadian Group Psychotherapy Foundation is committed to sponsoring the development of group therapists in Canada. The Jackman Foundation has generously donated \$2000 per year for five years (2009 – 2014), to support two senior training awards. These awards will support two Canadian group therapists seeking advanced training through attendance at the Institute and annual conference of the American Group Psychotherapy Association. (See [www.agpa.ca](http://www.agpa.ca)) *Applicants must have attended a CGPA Institute and Conference in the past.* Each \$1000 Jackman Training Award is to be used to attend the next Institute and Conference of the AGPA. (2012 AGPA conference and institutes will be held from March 5-10, 2012 in New York.) Successful applicants will also be referred to the AGPA Scholarship committee where they may be eligible for reduced conference registration fees as part of this award.

**Application procedure:** Applicants must submit a letter of intent, curriculum vitae, and proof of attendance at a previous CGPA Institute and Conference to: The Canadian Group Psychotherapy Foundation Training Awards Review Committee.
